



Grant County Women of Purpose News Release

Congratulations to USD #214 for receiving the 2013 grant from Women of Purpose. The grant totaling \$2,499.98 funded the curriculum for two important classes to be taught in Ulysses High School:

1. \$2,099.98 for Personal Money Management classes to be taught each year within the Business and Family & Consumer Science departments
2. \$400 for the money management portion of the Real Care Baby Think it Over Program taught within the Family & Consumer Science department.

Each year the founders of Women of Purpose choose an area of focus for their grant. This year the focus was Personal Financial Management. The founders felt this was a very important issue that affected everyone and for which meaningful and practical education was needed. Both of the USD #214 grants met the parameters of the focus.

Women of Purpose, a Designated Fund in the Grant County Community Foundation, was formed 2 years ago with a goal of inviting women of vision to join hands to create an endowment of \$50,000 to support the needs and causes of women and children in Grant County. We are thrilled to announce we have met that goal through generous donations of many Grant County women.

Our next goal is to invite 100 women to give \$100 each year to support the annual Women of Purpose grant. With each \$100 donation, \$50 will be allocated toward the current year's grant and \$50 will be added to the endowed fund. With 100 women each giving \$100, a grant of \$5,000 + interest will be available annually, and the endowed fund will continue to grow. Each donor is also entitled to vote on the grant recipient. It is easy—it is affordable—it will make a difference.
