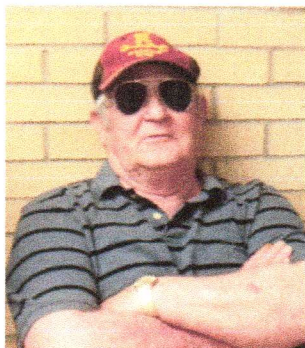

Obituary for Darrel Mangels
