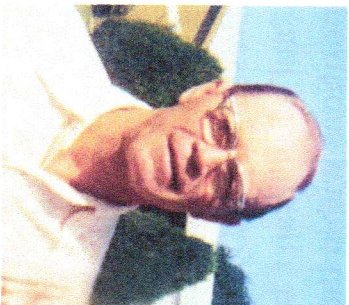

**Obituary for Roy Lee Bultman**

Roy Lee Bultman, 96, of Miller/Wessington and formerly of Elkhart, KS, passed away peacefully Wednesday, February 22, 2023, at the Evangelical Lutheran Good Samaritan Society, Miller, SD.

Roy was born on November 21, 1926, to Henry and Hilda (Scholle) Bultman in Carroll County, Carrollton, Missouri.

He attended the Lutheran Parochial School until they moved to Monett, Missouri in 1940 where he attended and completed his junior year of high school. During this time, Roy and his brothers joined their parents' custom wheat harvest operation. In the fall of 1944, Roy moved to Elkhart, KS where he completed his high school education and subsequently graduated in 1945. Roy served his country in the Armed Forces from 1950-1952 and while stationed at Fort Riley, KS, he met his precious wife, Dorothy Malone. They were married April 9, 1953, at Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Junction City, KS. He attended college in Stillwater, OK and later transferred to Wichita State University where he worked at the local Boeing plant in the evenings to support his family. Born to this union were a daughter, Lana, and two sons, Tony and Mark. After attending college and being honorably discharged from military service, Roy returned to Elkhart to resume his work with his dad and brothers in the family business.
