More Matching Funds!

The Grant County Forever Campaign has received an additional **\$100,000** match fund from a very generous donor who believes in the work that the Foundation is doing to help keep Ulysses the great place that it has been to live, work and raise our families.

In order to receive the full benefit of this match fund, Grant County Community Foundation needs to receive at least \$50,000 in donations by June 30th to capture first \$50,000 of the matching fund. The final \$50,000 must be received by December 31st.

The money raised through the Grant County Forever Campaign goes into an endowed fund to enable the Foundation to hire a full time Executive Director. The goal is \$1 Million in order to continue to fund the position with the earnings from this investment.
